IMPACT ON THE UNINSURED BY FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026

Medicaid expansion will reduce the number of uninsured non-elderly Coloradans by **189,000**

The percentage of uninsured Coloradans will drop to **7.7 percent** with Medicaid expansion versus **11.1 percent** with no expansion

IMPACT ON THE ECONOMY BY FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026

22,388 more jobs as a result of expansion



The state's economy, as measured by gross domestic product, will be **0.74%** larger, resulting in nearly

\$4.4BILLION

in additional economic activity as a result of expansion



Average annual household earnings

will be **\$608** higher

as a result of expansion
